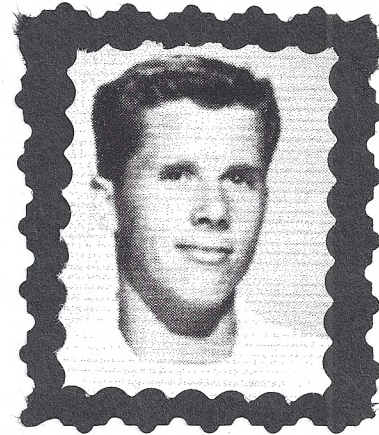


Tom Johnson Biography
